

# Instructions

## BBH-1 Bluebird House



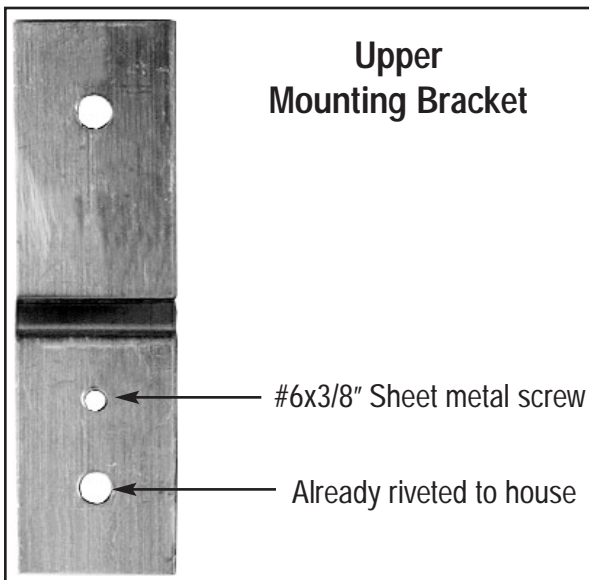
**NOTES:** (1) A complete assembled bluebird house is packed in this box.

(2) Hardware for house installation is included.

(3) It is necessary to install a post (not included) before house can be put up.

Congratulations! You have purchased a superior quality bluebird house manufactured by Nature House Inc. and approved by the North American Bluebird Society.

**1.** You will find in the enclosed hardware package: two #8x1" wood screws, and one #6x3/8" sheet metal screw.



**2.** In case it is not convenient to mount house on flat surface, we suggest using 1/2" or 5/8" plywood cut to 6"x14". This should be painted to protect from weather. In either case, use the #8 wood screws to attach the house to a flat surface or to the plywood. The plywood is for use on a steel post, using two U-bolts (not supplied) or on a rough post (using four screws not furnished).

**3.** Bluebird houses should be mounted on a post 4-5 feet above ground; 300 feet apart; and facing away from prevailing winds. Area around bluebird houses should be kept free of brush and tall grass. Placing bluebird houses 100 feet apart will provide housing for other beneficial cavity nesters such as tree swallows.
